

PROCLAMATION DECLARING A LOCAL DISASTER

WHEREAS, The City of Keene, Texas has suffered widespread and severe damage, loss of property, with the imminent threat continuing. This includes the potential for injury and loss of life as a result of heavy snow, prolonged freezing temperatures, impassable roads, and water loss.


WHEREAS, the full impact of this event is still evolving, and local resources have reached their limits and;

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Keene has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate suffering of the people and to protect life and property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 418.108 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, BY THE CITY OF KEENE MAYOR:


1. That a state of disaster has been declared for the City of Keene.
2. That the City of Keene Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless same is continued by consent of the City of Keene City Council.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
